For further details please see the Faculty of Social Sciences and Law webpage: http://www.bristol.ac.uk/fssl/official-documents/ A note regarding Council Tax Exemption - For the majority of students, your eligibility for Council Tax exemption will be confirmed with Bristol City Council electronically three times a year. You can view the date your details were last confirmed to Bristol City Council in Studentlnfo/ under your Term Address (see 'Last Notification Date to Bristol City Council'). Therefore, you should only need a council tax certificate from the Faculty if you are not resident within the Bristol City Council.
