If you have not already done so please ensure you do the following as soon as possible:



The **Accommodation Office** will be accepting [applications](#) from **03 May 2018** from offer-holders who are commencing study in September 2018. University accommodation is very popular so although the deadline is 30 June 2018 we recommend an early application.



Accept your offer, the earlier we know the more preparation we can do for your arrival. If you have not already done so please [respond](#) to your offer of study.



Certificate of Acceptance (CAS) number:

Masters applicants: If you are an international master's applicant now is the time to start thinking about the visa process. Unconditional Masters offer holders who have paid a [deposit](#) can now apply for a [Certificate of Acceptance of Studies \(CAS\) number](#). **We will be creating CAS numbers automatically and will be in contact with you**, however if you have not heard from us by the middle of June please email ed-masters-admiss@bristol.ac.uk

Doctoral Applicants: If you are an international doctoral applicant and require a student visa to study then your offer must be unconditional to apply for a [Certificate of Acceptance of Studies \(CAS\) number](#). You do not need to pay a deposit, however **if you do require a CAS number please email** ed-phd@bristol.ac.uk
