**Accept your offer**, the earlier we know the more preparation we can do for your arrival. If you have not already done so please <u>respond</u> to your offer of study.



## Certificate of Acceptance (CAS) number:

Masters applicants: If you are an international master's applicant now is the time to start thinking about the visa process. Unconditional Masters offer holders who have paid a <u>deposit</u> can now apply for a <u>Certificate of Acceptance of Studies</u> (CAS) <u>number.</u> We will be creating CAS <u>numbers</u> automatically and will be in contact with you, however if you have not heard from us by the middle of June please email ed-masters-admiss@bristol.ac.uk

**Doctoral Applicants:** If you are an international doctoral applicant and require a student visa to study then your offer must be unconditional to apply for a <u>Certificate of Acceptance of Studies (CAS) number.</u> You do not need to pay a deposit, however if you do require a CAS number please email edphd@bristol.ac.uk
