Fitness to Practise & Student Referrals: 2018-19 Data

The majority of referrals made about students do not result in fitness to practise implications, or the need to report information to professional bodies. The context for our referral process is supportive and developmental, with the aim of developing reflective professionals

In 2018/19, 202 referrals were received about 149 individual students, across the Faculty.

11 students were not progressed any further in the process.

91 students were referred for pastoral or academic support with the Senior Tutor, Academic & Support Team, Occupational Health Service or Faculty Student Advisors

47 students were deemed to have met the threshold for a Case Investigator Meeting

After the Case Investigator Meeting, 34 of these 47 students were either referred on for health or pastoral support or the case was closed

10 students receive a formal warning from a Case Investigator.

In 2018/19, 3 students are referred for a Formal Panel Hearing. All 3 remain on their programme with a formal warning and conditions or undertakings.
