## Local Information and Booking Form

### Location

The Victoria Rooms were built in 1840 as a place of assembly and hosted Jenny Lind, Charles Dickens and Oscar Wilde among many others in the 19th century. They are situated in the heart of Clifton, Bristol's fashionable Georgian suburb rivalling nearby Bath in historic interest.

A wide variety of restaurants for main meals is close to the Victoria Rooms, as are Bristol's mediaeval city centre and renovated waterfront.

### Accommodation

We recommend you approach one of the following hotels for accommodation, in descending order of proximity; The farthest from the Victoria Rooms, the Youth Hostel, offers basic, inexpensive accommodation.
